Way to ROUEN

Guided visit of the old town of ROUEN

The cathedral : located in the heart of the town, this jewel of gothic architecture is the symbol of ROUEN, "the town of 100 spires"

Visit of HONFLEUR : HONFLEUR on the Seine Estuary at the foot of the Côte de Grâce hill, is a delightful town. Its old dock, its church and old streets combine in singular harmony.

DAY 3

Tour to the D Day beaches

Visit of La Cambe German cemetery

Visit of the D DAY MUSEUM of ARROMANCHES which presents a unique collection of documents concerning this unforgettable day

Visit of a farm: cereals and pastures, apple trees for Calvados and cider production and dairy cows

City sight seeing of CAEN : Capital of Lower Normandy, Prefecture of the Calvados region, an industrial centre and river port, is a large bustling city. A cultural centre as well, it is an attractive town with houses built in CAEN stone, beautiful abbeys and churches, and fine modern buildings.

DAY 4

Way to LE MONT SAINT MICHEL

Visit of LE MONT SAINT MICHEL : a solitary island standing in the middle of a desert, that "Wonder of the Western World" leaves an indelible memory on every visitor, so individual is its setting, so rich its history and so perfect its architecture. Shrouded by mist, engulfed by sea, soaring proud above glistening sands, the silhouette of the MONT-SAINT-MICHEL is one of the most enchanting sights in France.

Way to SAINT MALO

Dinner and overnight in SAINT MALO

DAY 5

Guided visit of SAINT MALO : once a fortified island, SAINT-MALO stands in a commanding position at the mouth of the river Rance. Intra-muros, the old walled city, is encircled by ramparts that provide fine views of SAINT-MALO and its offshore islands. The Castle of SAINT-MALO, dates from the 14th-15th-centuries. The Fort National, was constructed in 1689 by Louis XIV's famous military architect, Vauban. The three-towered Tour Solidor in Saint-Servan was built in 1332 : formerly it was a prison.
