DISCOVER AGRICULTURE IN NORTH OF FRANCE



DAY 1 PARIS / AMIENS

Arrival in PARIS in the morning
Visit of a dairy farm in BEAUVAIS and lunch
Guided Visit of AMIENS, capital of the Picardy region. Amiens lies on the basin of the Somme. The old town is situated in a swampy area at the bottom of the valley. Visit of AMIENS Cathedral, the tallest of the large 'classic' Gothic churches of the 13th century. Visit the AMIENS hortillonnages: floating gardens over 300 hectares. A colourful patchwork of marshland market gardens, once tended by farmers using punts and now a protected natural site.
Dinner and overnight in AMIENS

DAY 2 CAMBRAI / ARRAS / LILLE

Road to CAMBRAI
Visit the confectioner's which producing the famous "bêtise de Cambrai"
Visit the mining museum LEWARDE, the biggest mining museum in France invites you to discover the history of coal-mining and the daily life of the miners in the Nord/Pas-de-Calais region, with a tour through its galleries and exhibitions.
Guided visit of ARRAS, known primarily for its Flemish baroque style, it will surprise you with its rich heritage but also with the lifestyle that characterizes the city.
Guided tour of the old LILLE: Explore the old quarters and enjoy the charms of a welcoming city. From one era to another, Lille has retained numerous buildings of multiple influences.
Dinner and overnight in LILLE

DAY 3 BRUGES / GHENT / LILLE

Guided tour of BRUGES, the capital and largest city of the province of West Flanders in Belgium. Such as Amsterdam, it is sometimes referred to as "The Venice of the North" because it is canal based.
Visit of a chocolate factory and chocolate tasting
Guided tour of GHENT, the capital and biggest city of the East Flanders province. Much of the city's medieval architecture remains intact and is well preserved.
Visit of a farm – breed "BLANC BLEU BELGE" in WIERS
Dinner and overnight in LILLE

DAY 4 BAILLEUL / STEENWERCK / CASSEL / LILLE

Visit of a farm / brewery in BAILLEUL and beer tasting
Way to STEENWERCK village
Visit the museum in STEENWERCK about the rural life and discovery of the Flemish traditions
Visit a windmill in CASSEL
Dinner and overnight in LILLE

DAY 5 ST OMER / ARQUES / BOULOGNE SUR MER

Departure for the area of ST OMER
Visit the ARQUES Glassmaking: you will discover how a small familial glassmaking managed to become a Tableware world leader.
Boat ride in the swamp of Audomarois : The last market garden's swamp in France, extends over 3500 acres and is cut by watergangs. Land of breeding farms but also vegetable culture, the swamp Audomarois will surprise you by its rich flora and unique wildlife.
Lunch in a farm in the heart of the swamp
Visit the distillery "Genièvre de Houlle" and tasting
Way to HELFAULT
Visit the Coupole HELFAULT: Built up by the Nazis between 1943 and 1944, "la Coupole" is an underground bunker, housing a huge concrete dome. Initially this bunker was to serve as a base to launch V2 rockets, but it never entered service because of the many bombing raids by the Allies.
Dinner and overnight in BOULOGNE SUR MER

DAY 6 BOULOGNE SUR MER / LES DEUX CAPS

Visit the port of BOULOGNE SUR MER , the leading European centre for processing, marketing and distributing seafood.
Walk on the site "LES DEUXCAPS" Listed as a national site, the Cap Blanc Nez cliff of white chalk is home to many birds which come to nest. At 132 meters above the sea level, you can admire beautiful landscapes of the Cote d'Opal ... and even England.
Way to DESVRES
Visit the earthenware house in DESVRES
