# DISCOVER ALSATIAN AGRICULTURE



## DAY 1 STRASBOURG

Arrival in Strasbourg

**Walking guided visit of STRASBOURG, capital of the Alsace and of Europe since 1949. The city is particularly known for its Gothic Cathedral and for its medieval cityscape of Rhineland black and white timber-framed buildings, particularly in the Petite-France alongside the ILL.**

## DAY 2 RIQUEWIHR / COLMAR

**Visit of the museum LIPS:** production of Alsatian Ginger Bread

**Visit of a Munster dairy** and munster tasting

Visit of a Montbeliarde farm which sells its production to the Munster dairy

**Stop in RIQUEWIHR, charming medieval village where the famous Riesling is produced. This city is surrounded by fortification.**

Dinner and overnight in COLMAR

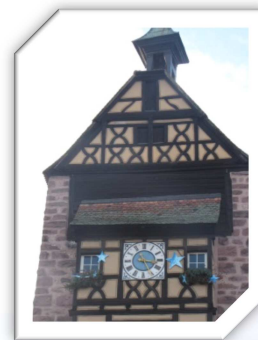
## DAY 3 COLMAR

**Guided visit of COLMAR in a touristic train, a purely Alsatian village with its traditional houses**

**Discovery of the "Route des crêtes". You will admire the most characteristic landscapes of the Vosges, its hills, its valleys, lakes. It offers panoramic views.**

**Visit of a wine cellar: presentation of the 7 alsacian grape variety and wine tasting**

## DAY 5 HAUT KOENIGSBOURG / STRASBOURG

**Guided visit of Haut Koenigsbourg, a fortified castle dated from XII century. This huge fortress was burnt down during the Thirty Years War in 1618. The Emperor of Germany, Guillaume II decided to rebuild it and he inaugurated it in 1908.**

**Boat cruise on the ILL to discover Strasbourg from the water**

**Visit of the Kronembourg brewery, discovery of the beer story and how to produce it**
