Way to TROYES

Sightseeing tour of the Old Town of TROYES When viewed from above, the old centre of Troyes is shaped almost exactly like a champagne cork. It is for this reason that locals refer to the old part of the city as the Bouchon de Champagne (French for "champagne cork"). In fact, this characteristic shape is a vestige of the past, the result of successive transformations of the city. It is a story that begins with the outline of the Gallo-Roman city, involves successive diversions of the River Seine, and ends with the erection and subsequent demolition of the ancient fortifications.

DAY 4 DIJON / BEAUNE / DIJON

Visit of the Hospices de Beaune, founded in 1442, they are a charity running hospitals and other services for the needy.

Guided visit of BEAUNE, a prestigious wine's city and the burgundy wine's capital. It is an ancient and historic town on the plain, by the hills of the Cote d'Or. You will find in the city, features from pre-Roman and Roman times, from the Antiquity, medieval, renaissance and modern times.

Visit of a wine Estate with burgundy wines (white and red) -tasting

Sightseeing tour of DIJON: The centre of Dijon is noted for its architectural splendour, a legacy from the Dukes of Burgundy. The capital of Burgundy, Dijon today has a rich cultural life and a renowned university. The city's great art treasures are housed in the Palais des Ducs.

Sightseeing Tour of AUXERRE: Beautifully sited overlooking the Yonne river, Auxerre justly prides itself on a fine collection of churches along with a charming pedestrian main square, the place Charles-Surugue. Sightseeing: The gothic Cathédrale St-Etienne and the abbey of St Germain.
